## RESOLUTION OF THE TRI-COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT OF OREGON HONORING KATHY WAI FOR HER SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE TRIMET BOARD OF DIRECTORS
